HANDICAP: Open to Amateur Golfers who are 35 years of age or over on the day of the competition and a Member of an affiliated Golf Club, with an active handicap not exceeding 9 under the current standard scratch score and handicapping scheme of C.O.N.G.U. Entries will **NOT** be accepted without a **CDHID** number.

ENTRANCE FEE: **£58 PER PERSON**, inclusive of sausage/bacon roll breakfast, 2 course lunch and sandwich tea. (PPGC Members £32 entry). Please note **NO** refunds are given after the draw sheet is published unless a replacement player is found.

PRIZES: Gross Score Prizes over 36 Holes: Winner - £250 / 2nd Place - £100 / 3rd Place - £60
Net Score Prizes over 36 Holes: Winner - £100 / 2nd Place - £60 / 3rd Place - £30
No player may win more than one prize.

CLOSING DATE: **Closing date: Monday, 31st August 2015.** Entry limit of 54 players, if numbers exceed 54 there will be a ballot on handicap for places. Start sheets will be published via email/website by Wednesday, 2nd September 2015.

NOTES: In accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of the Club. The decision of the Competition Committee will be final. All ties will be decided over the last 18, 9, 6 or 3 holes as appropriate. The competitor returning the lowest scratch medal score over 36 holes will hold the Mid Amateur Trophy for one year.
