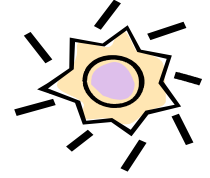




# 4-H Summer Adventures

## 2013 Class Descriptions



### 4-H OVERNIGHT CAMP

#### **4-H Residential Camp:** June 24-28, 2013; Early Bird Deadline May 10

Spend 5 days and 4 nights at North Central 4-H Camp June 24-28. Swim, hike, shoot archery or rifles and much more. For 4-H members aged 9-14. The \$200 registration fee covers all meals, lodging, and transportation to camp. Early Bird discount per camper if paid by May 10 is \$185. Three-month payment plans are available. ### 4-H DAY CAMPS

#### **4-H Pillowcase Project:** May 28, 29, 30, 31; 10 a.m.–2 p.m., Durr Annex, Edgewood

Youth aged 9 or older will create a pillowcase for themselves and one to donate to a shelter. This 4 day class is suitable for beginners. Beginners will learn the sewing machine and how to sew straight seams. Bring a lunch and a drink. All class materials will be provided. Cost: \$5.00

#### **4-H Crafts for Kids:** June 3, 4, 5; 10 a.m.-2 p.m., Durr Annex, Edgewood

On day one, youth will be working with our special guest, Fred Bauerle from The Home Depot. With his help we will be completing a wood working project for the fair. On day two and three, youth will be busy using recycle materials to create more works of art for the fair. Don't forget to bring a sack lunch. For Ages 9 to 12. Cost: \$10.00

#### **4-H Advanced Sewing:** June 6, 7; 10 a.m.-3 p.m., Durr Annex, Edgewood

Youth aged 12-18 will create non-clothing fun projects. This two-day class is suitable for advanced sewers. Class taught by Mary S. Averbeck and Master Clothing Volunteers. Bring a lunch and drink. All class materials provided. Cost: \$5.00

#### **4-H Beginning Photography:** June 11, 12; 10 a.m.-2 p.m., Durr Center, Marshall Road

Learn basic photography and correct photo selections suited for the Fair. If you have an eye for pictures and want to learn more about your camera, lighting, and what makes a strong photo, this is the class for you! Bring a sack lunch, your own camera, memory card and plenty of batteries. For Ages 9 and up. Cost: \$5.00

#### **4-H Photography Fair Preparation:** June 13; 10 a.m.-2 p.m., Durr Center, Marshall Road

Spend the day mounting your pictures properly for County and State Fair exhibit. **There will be no pictures taken this day.** Bring a selection of your prints with you and we will supply up to 4 pieces of matt board to each participant. Youth may participate in the 4H photography class held on June 11 & 12, but it is not necessary. For Ages 9 and up. Cost: \$10.00

#### **Calling All Teens!** June 19, 20; 10 a.m.-2 p.m., Durr Annex, Edgewood

Think you have Leadership potential? Come hang out with Karla and Julie for a couple of days of Leadership games and activities, a learning field trip and lots of fun! #### **4-H Record Book Writing Workshop:** June 20; 6:00-8:00 p.m., Durr Center, Marshall Road

#### **4-H Leathercraft:** June 21; 12:30 -2:00 p.m., Durr Center, Marshall Road

Steve Peyton of Tandy Leather will teach a wristband and keychain making class. The \$6.00 fee covers all materials/supplies. Youth that attend both sessions need to bring a lunch & drink. For Ages 9 and up. Cost: \$6.00.

**4-H Quilt Camp:** June 24, 25, 26, 27, 28; 10 a.m.-2 p.m., Durr Annex, Edgewood

This five-day program is for youth who have completed 4-H Sewing-Unit 1 or above. Youth will learn quilting techniques and complete a quilted project such as a candle mat, table runner, or wall hanging. Class taught by Mary S. Averbeck/Master Clothing Volunteers. Bring a lunch/drink. All class materials provided. For Ages 9 and up. Cost: \$5.00

**4-H Record Book Writing Workshop:** June 27; 12 noon-2 p.m., Durr Annex, Edgewood

**Blue Ribbon Baking: Making & Freezing Cookies** - July 3; 1 - 3 p.m., Durr Center, Marshall Road

Want some tips on baking 4-H projects that are real winners? Join us for this "hands-on" workshop where we will be making the chocolate Colossal Cookies from Level A: six Easy Bites Project book. We will also package some of our cookies to freeze for future fair entries. Note - you must be at least 9 years old to participate in this class. Class size is limited to 12. Taught by Kathy R. Byrnes, Kenton Co. Family & Consumer Sciences Agent. All materials provided. Cost: \$5.00

**4-H Creative Jewelry:** July 9; 10 am-2 pm, Durr Annex; July 10; 9:30 am-2 pm Bellevue Beadery

Youth will spend the first day making fun bead projects. We will visit the Bellevue Beadery the second day to create a beautiful piece of jewelry using all the professional tools and "County Fair" quality beads. Mom or an adult buddy will need to drive. If parents choose, they and siblings are welcome to make the jewelry as well for an additional fee (to be paid at the Beadery that day). Youth will need to bring a sack lunch. Adults may bring a lunch or buy lunch at a local restaurant. For Ages 9 and up. Cost: \$15.00 (for all participants). If paying after June 1, you must wait and pay at the beadery.

**4-H "If I Were A Dragon. . ." July 23, 24, 25; 10 a.m.-2 p.m., Durr Annex, Edgewood**

Calling all young authors and young artists! This class will stretch your creative thinking skills with the fun of drama, painting, and creative writing. Become whatever you dream of and reveal your image through different forms of expressive art. Don't forget to bring a sack lunch and plenty of imagination. For Ages 9 to 12. Cost: \$5.00

**Where Does Your Food Come From? July 25, 26; 10 a.m.-2:00 p.m., Durr Center, Marshall Road**

Join us as we explore wheat, corn, dairy, soy beans, honey and other Kentucky agricultural products. How do you make lip balm? Participate in many fun experiments and activities in this hand-on session. The experience will include making chocolate chip cookies and visiting the outdoor educational garden. For ages 9 & up. 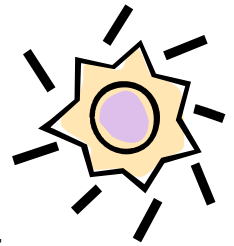
- The **Durr Annex** is located at 3099 Dixie Hwy. in Edgewood (K-Mart Plaza).

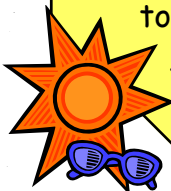
