PROGRAMME SELECTION CRITERIA

You are being offered the opportunity to study at a premier institute of learning. To be considered candidates:

CAM Selection Criteria:

- Ideally be a person from a previously disadvantaged background;
- Must write a letter to motivate why you, as a potential candidate, should be considered. Part of this motivation must indicate the level of need.
 - Note: Applications will not be considered without an accompanying letter of motivation and an indication of need.
- Candidate must show financial need by disclosing salary information,
- Candidate must be in good academic standing on the AIM programme.

The University of Cape Town – Graduate School of Business (UCT-GSB) selection and admissions criteria:

- Must meet the UCT-GSB academic selection criteria for the relevant course;
- Must be supported by your employer, be employed, or be in business in your own right;
- Must have two referees who have known you professionally for 3 years and can vouch for your suitability;

You will need to fulfil all of these criteria in order to be selected to participate.

All applicants should note that we expect a large number of applications.

The decision of the committee will be final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into regarding individual selection.

CAM SUPPORT OF CANDIDATES

The CAM will fund the programme fees or an appropriate proportion thereof. The fees for 2013 are **R31 000**.

The final decision in the awarding of funding will only be made after the second term's academic results have been published.
