## Family Home Evening Ideas

1. Read "A Prophet's Love" (pages 2–3) and do the "Climbing the Stairs" activity on page 2. Make a goal to serve in the three ways you listed throughout the week.

2. Read "The Pumpkin Experiment" (pages 4–6). What effect did Abby's kindness have on Rachel? Fill a glass with water and add a few drops of food coloring. Watch as the water changes color.
