We'll learn how to further *personalize our paper by lettering* a favorite poem or use our newly honed skills at Lombardic capitals to add a letter with special meaning. Harvest will teach us *image transfer techniques* that will create a magical look that will age our documents to a century ago.

Harvest says, "This class is about having fun, experimenting with different techniques, and letting go of predetermined outcomes. Come play, make a mess and see what wonders will appear!
