- Brushes: #2 or #4 round brushes (don't have to be sable but should have a good point).
- Any other wonderful brushes you would like to try.
- 2" or 3" sponge brush (for making washes) and kitchen sponge.
- Regular calligraphic pens (equivalent to 1mm Brause AND pointed nibs you like to use).
- Gel Pens (gold or silver: Sakura Gelly Roll).
