What does the United Methodist Church believe? What is Bishop Wallace-Padgett’s response? What does your pastor have to say about the issue? What does the Bible have to say? How will all of this impact the local church? You may have some of these questions and more.

You are invited to come be part of the conversation on February 16 at 12pm (bring a brown bag lunch), February 22 at 6:30 pm, or February 24 at 6pm. The conversation will look at answering some of the previously mentioned questions, as well as a time of prayer. This will be a time of respectful dialogue and is open to anyone who would like to be a part of the conversation.
