LATE ENTRIES WILL ATTRACT A \$10 LATE FEE PER ENTRY

Players are advised to retain this part of the tournament conditions for their own information, noting the entry conditions.

<u>Withdrawals</u>: Players who withdraw from an event after 24 September 2015, or withdraw from an event during the tournament, will be penalised under the TA and MA Events Disciplinary Policy, except in those cases where a medical certificate or other reasonable cause is provided for non-participation. Withdrawal notification must be in writing and submitted to the Tournament Director. Evidence in support of the withdrawal (ie. medical certificate, etc) must be submitted to the Tournament Director within seven days of the withdrawal notification. Refund will be on a sliding scale as per AMT Rules & Regulations. <u>Entries</u>: The maximum number of events a player can enter is 3. Players entering 18/U events can also enter Open events (restricted to 3 events only). Players entering 'A' Grade or 'B' Grade events are restricted to playing one grade.

Open and 18/U Events Consolation: In Open and 18/U singles events, the first two round losers will be eligible to sign on for consolation events on Friday night.

Doubles: If a player has entered a doubles event without a partner, the procedure for pairing these players will be as follows: paired up with the next highest ranked player without a partner, once all ranked players have been allocated a partner, any remaining unranked players will be paired by random draw. **Exemptions:** Players must be available at all times during the tournament. No time exemptions will be granted.

<u>Matches</u>: All mens and womens doubles for Open and 18/U events will be knock out events. Open and 18/U mixed events will be short sets. All grade events and veterans events shall be round robin format. **Program**:
