Introduction

Since 2003, AgIndustries Research & Consulting, Inc.'s (AgIndustries') **U.S. Controlled-Release Fertilizer Imports and Exports Monitoring Service** has provided client companies marketing controlled-release fertilizers (CRFs) in the United States with market intelligence that assists them to:

- Identify and track CRF products entering the U.S. market from off-shore sources
- Track U.S. export shipments of CRF and CRF-based products by exporting company and country of destination
- Follow trends and recognize significant changes in CRF imports or exports by company, product, and/or country.

The 2012 Monitoring Service will continue to provide subscribers with monthly monitoring, analysis, and reporting of water-borne shipments of CRF products to and from the world's largest market. This prospectus outlines the scope of the Monitoring Service for 2012, describes the deliverables, and indicates the anticipated reporting schedule.

Although the monitoring service was not offered in 2011, because of other AgIndustries project commitments, companies needing CRF imports and exports data for 2011 can now subscribe to a 2011 summary report that will provide the full year's imports and exports data, plus analysis of significant trends during that year.

Objectives

The overall objective of the Monitoring Service is to provide companies in the global specialty fertilizers industry with continuing monitoring, analysis, and timely reporting of U.S. imports and exports of CRF products. The 2012 Monitoring Service will provide subscribers with monthly reports on:

- **U.S. imports** of the following products:
 - Urea-formaldehyde (UF)-based CRF products (e.g., Sazolene ®)
 - IBDU
 - Polymer-coated fertilizers (Meister[®], Multicote[®], Nutricote[®], Osmocote[®], Plantacote Pluss[®], others)
 - Other manufactured CRF products (e.g., planting tablets, briquettes)
 - Granular NPK substrates for polymer-coated fertilizers.
- U.S. exports of the following:
 - Solid UF-based fertilizers

Objectives (Continued)

- Liquid UF-based fertilizers
- Polymer-coated sulfur-coated urea (PCSCU)
- Polymer-coated fertilizers
- MagAmp[®]
- Fertilizer spikes and tablets
- Specialty fertilizers exported by companies known to produce and/or market blended or homogeneous granular turf or ornamental fertilizer products containing CRF materials
- Nitrogen stabilizers and stabilized nitrogen fertilizers.

Each monthly report will provide the following information and data on **U.S. CRF imports** on a shipment-by-shipment basis, as available:

- Vessel arrival date
- Commodity description (as per ship's manifest)
- Product trade name and/or CRF product type
- Name and location (city and country) of the foreign shipper (which may be the product manufacturer or another company such as a freight forwarder)
- Name of the product manufacturer
- Country of origin
- Port of origin
- Intermediate foreign port, if any
- Name and location (city and state) of the U.S. importing company
- U.S. port of entry
- Destination city and state
- Ship line
- Estimated cargo value
- Quantity (number of units)

Objectives (Continued)

- Unit of measure (package type; e.g., bag, bulk bag)
- Cargo weight in pounds, short tons, and metric tons.

Monthly reports on **U.S. CRF exports** will provide the following information by individual shipment, as available:

- Vessel sailing date
- Commodity description (as per ship's manifest)
- Product trade name and/or CRF product type
- Name and location (city and state) of the U.S. exporter
- Name of the product manufacturer
- Origin city and state
- U.S. port of export
- Foreign intermediate port, if any
- Foreign port of destination
- Country of destination
- Ship line
- Estimated cargo value
- Quantity (number of units)
- Unit of measure (package type)
- Cargo weight in pounds, short tons, and metric tons.

Please note that the Service monitors only water-borne U.S. CRF imports and exports. Truck and rail shipments to or from Canada or Mexico are not part of the Service's scope.

Approach

Imports and exports of CRF products are not identifiable in publicly available U.S. government foreign trade reports and databases. Accordingly, in researching CRF markets, AgIndustries relies on **UBM** Global Trade, Inc.'s *Port Import Export Reporting Service* (PIERS) electronic database as the primary basis for estimating U.S. CRF imports and exports by product type. Drawing on bills of lading and vessel manifests from every leading U.S. port, the PIERS database contains information on individual water-borne shipments of all types of fertilizers to and from the United States.

Although the PIERS data are detailed, a considerable amount of analysis is required to determine the specific products that are being imported and exported, given that the information that PIERS copies directly from vessel manifests is often incomplete and/or misselled. Furthermore, manifest cargo descriptions are often nonspecific (e.g., "fertilizer" or "fertilizer, nonhazardous").

For the 2012 Monitoring Service, relying on our experience in working with the PIERS database and our knowledge of CRF products, manufacturers, and production locations, AgIndustries will select the appropriate records from the PIERS database, analyze these data in order to fill in blanks, and identify products by trade name and/or product type. This analysis will entail a certain amount of conjecture when information is incomplete, but given our extensive knowledge of the field, AgIndustries is confident that we can provide subscribers with valuable clarification of uncertainties in the PIERS data.

Deliverables and Schedule

Subscribers to the **U.S. Controlled-Release Fertilizer Imports and Exports Monitoring Service** for 2012 will receive monthly reports, each consisting of two Microsoft Excel spreadsheet files—one for imports and one for exports. In each file, the individual shipment data will be sorted and subtotaled by product type and/or by specific CRF product. The spreadsheet format will allow subscribers to re-sort the shipment records according to their particular interests or requirements.

AgIndustries will also provide four quarterly summary reports and a final annual summary report. The quarterly summary reports will summarize and compare CRF imports and exports by product in the respective quarters for 2011 and 2012. The final annual report will summarize and compare CRF imports and exports by product in calendar years 2011 and 2012, and will also include annotations indicating significant departures from trends since January 2011 (e.g., declines or spikes in shipments; marked variations in imports in regard to national origins, in tonnages shipped from specific countries, or in destinations for products of U.S. manufacturers). The quarterly and annual summary reports will consist primarily of Excel spreadsheets and charts. Annotations will be provided in a Microsoft Word document. Delivery of all reports will be by e-mail. The delivery schedule we anticipate is shown on the following page.

2011 Summary Report

Subscribers to the 2011 Summary report will receive two Microsoft Excel spreadsheet files one for import shipments from January 1-December 31, and the other for export shipments from January 1-December 31. Summary and analysis of the 2011 imports and exports data will be provided in a Microsoft Word document and Excel tables and charts. The 2011 summary report will be delivered in July 2012.

Contractual Terms

Subscription Fees

The fee to subscribe to the **U.S. Controlled-Release Fertilizer Imports and Exports Monitoring Service** for calendar year 2012 is US\$4,500. The fee to subscribe to the 2011 U.S. Controlled-Release Fertilizer Imports and Exports Summary report is US\$2,000.

The fee to subscribe to both the 2012 Monitoring Service and the 2011 Summary report is US\$5,500, representing a discount of US\$1,000 (more than 15%) off the total fee.
