OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM**

June 27, 2006, at 9:30 A.M.

The Council of the City of Birmingham met in the Council Chambers of the City Hall of Birmingham on June 27, 2006 at 9:30 a.m., in regular meeting.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Pastor Lee A. Henderson, Sr., Pastor of Tabernacle of Praise Ministries.

The minutes of June 6, 2006 were approved as submitted.

William Gilchrist, Director of Planning, Engineering and Permits noted that Item No. 31 on the Council Agenda, is being funded with Bond Fund money.

Mayor Bernard Kincaid presented the following proclamation:

June 27, 2006 is proclaimed "HIV Testing Day," in the City of Birmingham.

Councilmember Smitherman made a motion to suspend the rules to allow for presentations, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Witherspoon, and adopted.

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Councilmember Smitherman recognized Winston Strickland and members of Mad Skillz Dance Company who won the Wide Eye Dance Competition, who presented all Councilmembers and the Mayor with Mad Skillz dance shirts.

Councilmember Bell recognized Ed Spencer and Lou McCravey of Dean's Foods for their participation in the Martin Family Case, through Barber's Diary their subsidiary, and for posting a reward not only in the Martin case, but also in other cold cases in Birmingham.

Councilmember Abbott recognized Tom Struzik from U.A.B. School of Public Health and Frank Phillips of the Jefferson County health Department who spoke on "Mosquito Awareness Week," sponsored by the Mosquito Control Association.
