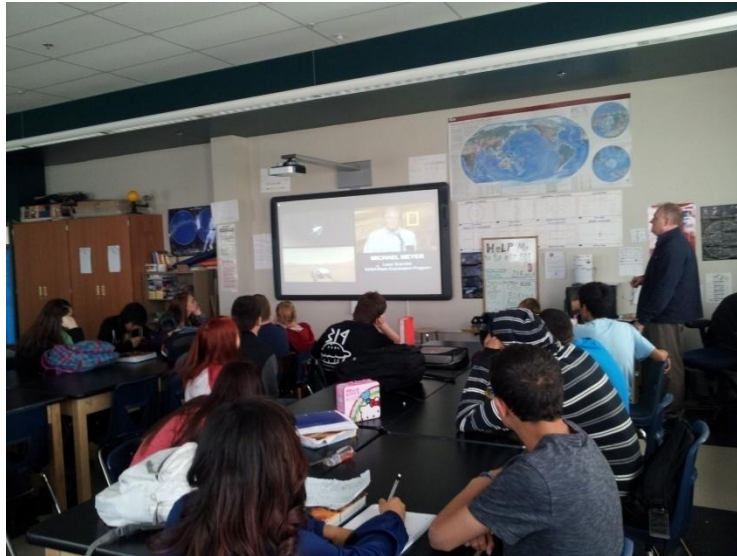


# High School Weekly Update

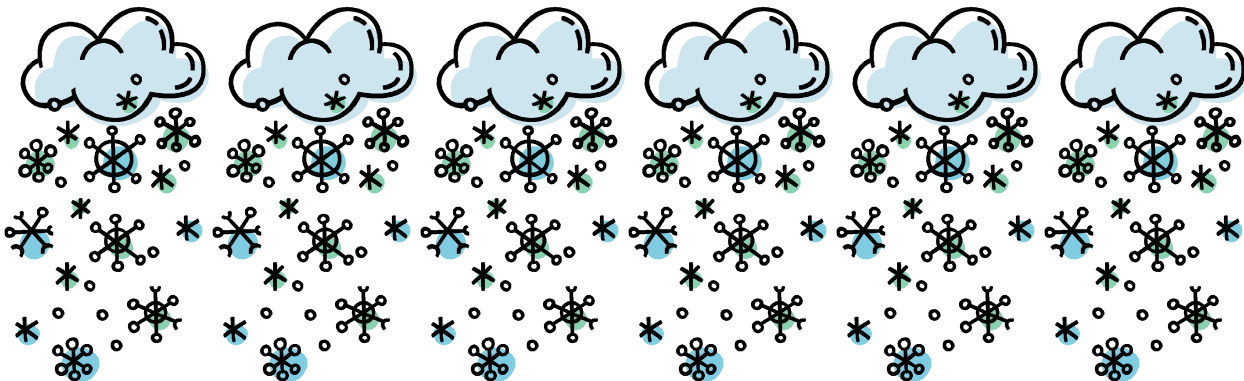

## **FREE SUMMER BREAKFAST AND LUNCH PROGRAM**

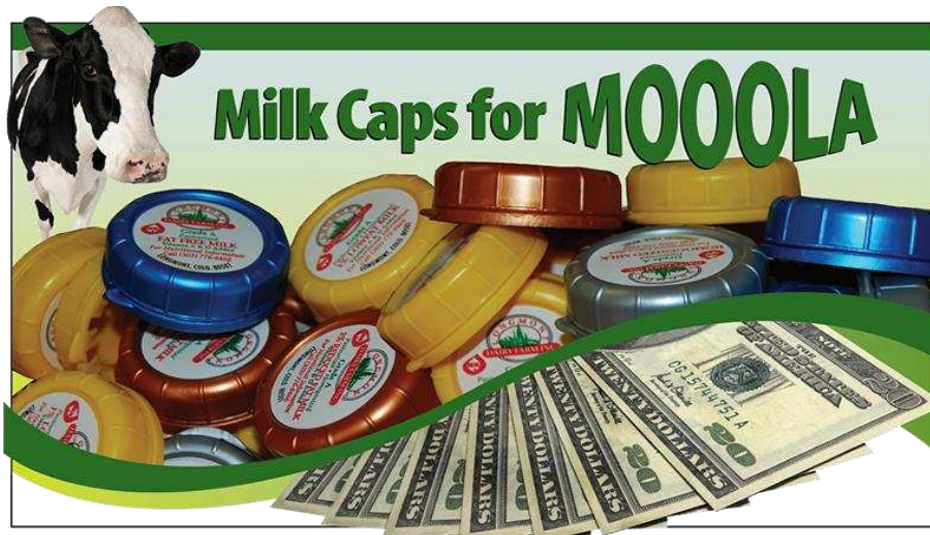
