This innovative program strives to encourage elementary and middle school students to read independently. It does so by rewarding young people with a waterpark pass as an incentive, based on the number of books they read during "March is Reading Month."

By focusing the excitement of the waterpark on independent reading, the READING RANGER program promises to become an important tool for teachers who want to support their students' efforts to read more books.

Each school can adapt the READING RANGER program requirements to meet its specific needs and benchmarks.

The suggested minimum number of pages required to earn a free reading ranger Waterpark pass is listed on the Reading Log that is distributed to the student. Please adjust to appropriate levels for individual classrooms. Minutes are acceptable.

New in 2014! Reading Rangers is going digital! All forms are writable PDFs and need to be submitted via email.

#### **Program Overview:**

There is no registration necessary for entry into the Reading Rewards Program. Please designate one program coordinator to be in charge of distributing all program materials to teachers of participating classrooms and submitting final paperwork to Oakland County Parks and Recreation.

If multiple classrooms from a school are participating in the program, please submit all final paperwork together.

Students must read books at their individual reading levels outside of the classroom assignments. Each time a student reads, he or she will record it on their Reading Log. The teacher will verify that the student successfully read the book for understanding. Teachers will keep track of all qualifying students in their classroom on the Teacher Report Form.

The program coordinator is responsible for submitting the **Teachers Report Form(s)** and the **Ticket Request** Form to Oakland County Parks by April 21, 2014. Late forms will not be accepted. Please do not submit the students individual Reading Logs. Only ONE teacher per classroom is eligible for the teacher ticket. If more than one teacher is listed, only one pass will be sent. If the student(s) is home-schooled, only ONE parent/guardian/ teacher is eligible for the teacher ticket per household.

Oakland County Parks will mail the earned and requested number of waterpark passes to the program coordinator (not to individual teachers and classes), it is their responsibility to distribute the passes to the participating classrooms and students.

Passes **cannot** be used for group trips or school field trips.

The waterpark passes may be redeemed between Memorial Day and Labor Day of 2014. Please refer to DestinationOakland.com for waterpark information. Early and late season hours may vary.




