FOR YOUR PONY - Hay & Feed for the week, Muck Out Sack/Container, Yard Brush, Fork, 3 Buckets, Head Collar & Rope, Correctly fitting Saddle & Bridle, Cleaning Brushes, Hoof Pick, Mane Comb, Plaiting Bands, Saddle Soap & sponge, Large Sponge, Sweat Scraper, Curry Comb.

FOR YOURSELF - Back Protector (level 3) & Crash Helmet (safety standard BSEN 1384/PAS 015), Jodphurs, Waterproof Gear, Large Lunch & Drinks (it can be a long tiring day.)

Please clearly label all your clothing, tack and grooming kit

Second Hand Shop at Camp where you can bring or buy tack & clothes in good condition

3. **Junior Camp applicants must have attended 3 ridden activities prior to camp**

This is essential so Area Managers know their standard of riding & suitability of their pony to attend camp. This also facilitates selecting the correct 'Ride' i.e. group that your child will be with for the week of camp. There can be no change of pony between rallies and camp without permission. In the interest of safety all Ponies/Horses must be over 5 yrs old and used to being ridden in company. Should a pony misbehave or become lame or sick that pony will be asked to leave & refunded.

4. **Help with catering one day of camp.**

One of the biggest tasks during the week is to provide food for instructors/organisers/helpers. This year as both camps are running simultaneously we will need extra help. Each area manager has one day that provide the catering with the help of many parents. Please contact your AREA MANAGER prior to Camp with offers of help or food or perhaps you could give a few hours to help with "the orange run" etc. on a given day.

5. **Pony/Horse must have a Passport with current vaccinations .**

Do it NOW & Avoid disappointment

Please ensure your pony/horse has the correct updated 2012 Vaccinations on the passport. The minimum requirement for entry to the Punchestown Racing Stables are 2 primary injections 21 days apart prior to camp starting.

ON THE 1ST MORNING OF CAMP ALL PASSPORTS ARE CHECKED. NO PONY CAN ENTER THE STABLE YARD WITHOUT A PASSPORT WITH *CURRENT* VACCINATIONS SIGNED BY YOUR VET. FOR FURTHER ADVICE PLS CONTACT YOUR VET OR AREA MANAGER.

NB Markings Charts are no longer recognised as identification. You must have a Passport for each animal. Passports can be obtained for €25 from IPC HQ please fill out the 'Passport Application' form and send to IPC HQ

6. **Parents remaining during camp**

We would be thrilled if parents could offer to help during camp particularly on the first & last day. In the instance of a parent wishing to remain in Punchestown to observe their child that is no problem once they have informed the committee member in charge on that given day, and permission given.
