Blue & White Gis <u>are required</u> for 17 - 20 year olds & Senior Elite Divisions. All athletes and/or clubs must bring their own BLUE & WHITE Belts/Sashes for Juniors, Senior Novice & Veterans. IJF Approved Gis are not required. Official IJF Back patches are not required

USA JUDO NATIONAL REFEREE CERTIFICATION TEST INFORMATION

The 2015 Pedro's Judo Challenge will be a National Referee Certification Testing Event for USA Judo. The referee staff will include Mel Appelbaum, Rick Celotto, and Roy Englert.

All candidates must:

- 1. Attend clinic Saturday morning and register for the test at that time. Registration: 7:30 8:00am. Clinic: 8:00 9:00am.
- 2. Have proof of the following US citizen or have legal resident alien status, age (18 and over), rank (shodan or higher), current USJI member, certificate of regional referee (minimum of one year)
- 3. Pay \$20.00 examination fee and \$20.00 certification fee if passed
- 4. Records of last three years officiating and referee clinics attended
- 5. Two passport size photos taken in referee attire

All referees must wear official referee attire, or Pedro's Challenge Polo shirt.

Candidates will have to pass the written examination (multiple choice) and will have to referee at the event to the satisfaction of the examiners.

- 1. Acknowledge that I am familiar with the sport of Judo and understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
- 2. Agree that, prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and, if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.
- Acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, including traumatic brain injury (TBI), permanent disability or death, and severe social and economic losses due to not only my own actions, inactions, or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
- 4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks, and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability, or death.
