Third paragraph: close by thanking the donor again and make a commitment to do well with the donor investment.

Example: By awarding me the [name of scholarship], I will be able to focus on my education and put all my energy into doing well in my classes. Your generosity is allowing me to make my goals and dreams a reality. I hope in turn one day I'll be able to give back and help other students achieve their goals.
