Playing/training area Provide a description and check that the area and surroundings are safe and free from obstacles and that the area is fit and appropriate for the activity.	
The area of Eversley Cricket Club known as the 'Pony Field' is to the east of the main ground. The land was converted from a pony field in 2009 and formally opened in Spring 2010. The ground is bordered on all sides by a wooden post and rail fence. To the north there is a small strip of rough ground and a telegraph post. The ground consists of a large flat 'grassed' playing area and a small square of rolled ground suitable for a soft ball game of cricket. Access on foot is from a path accessed from the main ground car park or the indoor centre car park. The ground is largely free from obstacles and vehicle access is restricted. The rough ground to the north does have some 'rabbit holes' which could potentially cause a minor injury if a foot was stuck in them and there are guide cables from the telegraph pole that are a potential trip hazard.	
Equipment Check that it is fit and sound for activity and suitable for age group/ability.	
The ground has specifically been adapted to play junior 'softball' cricket. All appropriate equipment and kit to play cricket and run coaching sessions is provided to the coaches and captains/managers of the playing sides including First Aid kits.	
Participants Check that the attendance register is up to date with medical information and contact details. Check that the players are appropriately attired for the activity.	
During colts training and matches a register of all participants is taken. All players are required to be appropriately attired and safe for activity.	
Emergency procedures Emergency vehicles can access facilities. A telephone is available in the main club house. A notice has been placed at the entrance to the adjacent Eversley Indoor Cricket Centre with emergency numbers and directions for emergency services.
