Since October 1958, BCPOA has been dedicated to making Bay Colony a GREAT place to live. Volunteers with the organization actively protect the welfare of our neighborhood.

In the past, the BCPOA has been involved in negotiating for lowering and eliminating costs for 'long' distance phone calls, converting from septic to sewer systems, and supporting the designation of Terra Ceia Bay as an Aquatic Preserve and Outstanding Florida Waterway. More recently or on an ongoing basis, BCPOA:

- Arranged for Manatee County to dredge Bay Colony's canals at a reasonable pro-rated cost. Dredged canals increase property value and enable boaters to enjoy the Bay and Gulf during all tides, year round.
- Has fun social events (annual holiday dinner, family BBQ, wine tastings, etc.) that
 provide opportunity for neighbors to get to know each other and strengthen the
 bonds of the community.
- Engages local law enforcement in educating and protecting our neighborhood.
- Maintains the Bay Colony sign and surrounding grounds.
- Produces the Bay Colony Directory with useful neighborhood information, such as the names and contact information of Bay Colony home owners.
