MISSION:

The Tuality Healthcare Foundation exists to support and assist Tuality Healthcare in fulfilling its mission of building a healthier community.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDING: The Tuality Healthcare Foundation Scholarship Committee is authorized to award cash grants to area high school seniors pursuing a human healthcare related career.

Upon her retirement in 1992, the Flo Rhea Health Careers Endowment Scholarship was established to pay tribute to Flo's 12 years of service to Tuality Healthcare. Funds were raised for this endowed scholarship amongst Flo's family and friends. This scholarship is a reminder of Flo's outstanding inspiration, values, and commitment to the future of healthcare by investing in the young people of our community. The Flo Rhea Health Careers Endowment Scholarship will award one (1) \$1,300 scholarship to a student pursuing a career in a human healthcare related field. The scholarship is to be used during the 2016-2017 school year at a 2 or 4 year college or vocational school.

Dr. Marvin J. Robb practiced medicine at Tuality Community Hospital for 38 years and retired in 1983. In 2007, Marlys Carter, a Tuality Healthcare Foundation Board Member, established the Dr. Marvin J. Robb Memorial Scholarship in honor of Dr. Robb's many years of service to the community. The Dr. Marvin J. Robb Memorial Scholarship will award one (1) \$2,000 scholarship to a student pursuing a career in a human healthcare related field. The scholarship is to be used during the 2016-2017 school year at a 2 or 4 year college or vocational school.

ELIGIBILITY & SELECTION CRITERIA

Each applicant must be a current graduating high school senior attending one of the following schools: Aloha, Banks, Century, Faith Bible Christian, Forest Grove, Gaston, Glencoe, Hillsboro, Liberty, Life Christian, Miller Education Center or Westview. Selection criteria will be based on the following:

- Applicant must be pursuing a career in a human healthcare related field
- Applicant must have a cumulative (unweighted) GPA of 3.5 or higher
- Applicant must have a SAT score of 1400 or ACT score of 20 or higher. Test scores must be submitted by the school on the official transcript. Screenshots or printouts from a student's testing account will not be accepted.
- Specific classes relating to goal
- Specific goal within a human healthcare related career
- Extracurricular activities (especially those relating to goal)

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- 1. Application forms will be available at the end of February in the career counseling centers of the aforementioned high schools.
- Completed application, current transcript, official SAT or ACT test scores and one letter of recommendation must be e-mailed to melanie.johnson@tuality.org or faxed to (503) 681-1942 by April 1, 2016 at 4:30 p.m. Late applications will not be accepted. Please call 503-681-1170 with any questions.
- 3. If selected for an interview, the applicant will be contacted on or around April 20, 2016. Interviews will be held on Monday, April 25, 2016 from 5:30 pm 8:30 pm. This is the only interview date scheduled. In order to qualify for the scholarship, the applicant must be able to participate in the interview process.
- 4. Scholarship awards will be presented to the recipient at their school's annual award assembly.
