3. Child(ren) must arrive by 9:00 a.m. to eat breakfast. All children must arrive by 9:30 a.m. to be admitted to the classroom. You will have a one-time grace period of 5 minutes (by 9:35 a.m.) NO EXCEPTIONS. Continuous late arrivals can result in termination. (Handbook page 25)	Initial Here:
4. ALL parents/guardians must fill out the Sign In/Sign Out Sheet every morning and evening when the child is dropped off and picked up.  NO EXCEPTIONS (Handbook page 14)	Initial Here:

On the 6 <sup>th</sup> day, your child will be terminated unless you can provide an excuse from qualified medical staff and/or a hospital. <b>NO EXCEPTIONS</b> . 9. Parents who receive a voucher for child care are allowed 15 days of vacation each year. You must provide the Center your request for vacation two weeks in advance of the time you want your child to be out of class. Please ask the administrative assistant for the pre-printed letter. 10. Shiloh Child Development Center teachers walk school age students to and from their respective schools (KIPP and Seaton ES).
