- Elizabeth Mullikin Consultant 2015 Facility Based Training Scholarship. This \$250 scholarship will cover one Full Student registration to the 2015 ASET Annual Conference. To be eligible for the scholarship, the applicant must be enrolled in an on-the-job training program for EEG technologists.
- □ Lifelines Neurodiagnostic Systems 2015 Continuing Education Scholarship. This \$250 scholarship will cover the cost of one Full Student registration to the 2015 ASET Annual Conference. To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must be preparing to take the R. EEG T. exam within one year from the conclusion of the conference.
- □ Lifelines Neurodiagnostic Systems 2015 Professional Development Scholarships. <u>Two</u> \$500 scholarships are available. Each will cover the cost of one Full registration to the 2015 ASET Annual Conference. To be eligible for these scholarships, applicants must be employed full-time (or work full-time as an independent contractor) as an EEG technologist.
- Nihon Kohden America 2015 Continuing Education Scholarship. This \$750 scholarship will cover the cost of one Full registration to the 2015 ASET Annual Conference and \$250 to be used by the recipient to offset travel expenses to the event. To be eligible for the scholarship, the applicant must meet the ASET member qualifications.
- □ Rochester Electro-Medical 2015 Professional Development Scholarship. This \$500 scholarship will cover the cost of one Full registration to the 2015 ASET Annual Conference. To be eligible for the scholarship, the applicant must meet the ASET member qualifications.
- ❑ Weaver and Company 2015 Continuing Education Scholarships. <u>Two</u> \$500 scholarships are available. Each will cover the cost of one Full registration to the 2015 ASET Annual Conference. To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must meet the ASET member qualifications.

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❑ ASET Scholarship. You may use this form to also apply for an ASET Scholarship to attend the 2015 ASET Annual Conference by checking this box. Funded by the ASET Foundation, an ASET Scholarship covers the cost of one Full registration to the event.
