Policy Section 5.0 - School Trip Conduct

- 5.1 The School Code of Conduct is in effect when students are on school trips.
- 5.2 Before and during a school trip, teachers and chaperones shall demonstrate responsible behavior and promote an attitude of cooperation and safety awareness.
- 5.3 Students shall be responsible for demonstrating courtesy, cooperation, and safety awareness while on school trips.

Failure of students to comply with the code of conduct may result in parents being contacted to arrange immediate transportation home and may also include suspension from other school trips. Mr. Brown, as the teacher in charge, will provide a list of guidelines for all chaperones. Safety is the number one concern for students so we ask that parents/guardians review the school's code of conduct with your child prior to giving permission for the trip. It is available on the school website. Bedford Junior High students have a history of excellent behavior on school trips and this is a contributing factor to staff's willingness to arrange such opportunities. We look forward to our students having an enjoyable and enriching learning experience.
