**Curriculum:** Composition, notation, sight singing, melodic and rhythmic dictation, theory, harmony, counterpoint, text setting, music history, public speaking, creating a resume, conducting, notation software, visiting musicians and composers, instrument background, NOTE TBA: Composer Cooperative and Berkeley Symphony Orchestra concerts, Live from the Met field trips, possible interdisciplinary collaboration, rehearsals and performances.

**Expectations:** Students will be expected to do all assigned homework, create/update a resume, attend all field trips, as well as write 2 compositions during the course; 1 for voice (focusing on text setting) and one instrument of choice performed January 30 and 1 chamber work, performed by professional musicians at MIM's SummerFest in June (early-mid) tba.
