Portfolio activities and products at each grade level are designed sequentially to help students produce the final culminating project portfolio. Students shall have the following components, approved by their advisor, and placed in their portfolio by the end of each year.

Core Portfolio Contents

Learner

- Box Sheet- Sheet Typed, Completed Boxes Checked off and Printed.**
- Best Works- Three of the Twelve: Typed, Printed and Signed. Artifacts Attached.**
- Autobiographical Writing- Final Edit Typed and Printed.**
- Academic History- Transcript: Senior Year 1st Sem, Test Scores (WASL, ACT, SAT)**

Citizen

- Volunteer Service Record- Complete 50+ hours. All forms signed.**

Transition

- Resume- Final Edit Typed and Printed.**
- Letter of Recommendation- Sheet Typed and Printed. (No letters needed)**
- Post HS Action Plan- Sheet Typed and Printed. (Pick only one of Four Sheets)**

Evaluation

- Portfolio TOC- (This sheet) All boxes checked, Form Printed/Placed after Title Page.**
- Portfolio- Complete and Organized. (A Title Page in Front of Portfolio)**
- PowerPoint- Completed. Emailed to Adviser. Printed (Six slides per page)**
- Portfolio Rubric- Print and Place before Title Page. (Adviser will fill this out)**
- Presentation Rubric- (Adviser will complete and place form after your presentation)**
