Chaperone Code of Conduct

The goal of the Relay for Life of Somers is to provide a safe, fun and positive experience for both youth and adults. As a Chaperone, you play a valuable role in attaining this goal. Please read through this code of conduct and sign below.

Chaperones are needed from 11:00PM until 7:00AM. Teams without a Chaperone must leave the event by 11:00PM.

Chaperones shall:

- 1. Complete and carry with them during the event the Youth Emergency Contact Sheet.
- 2. Respect the individual rights, safety, and property of others.
- 2. Treat all youth fairly and not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, color, national origin, sex, marital status, sexual orientation, age, veteran status, medical condition or disability.
- 3. When transporting themselves or others, have a valid driver's license, carry proof of automobile liability insurance, and make sure all passengers use seat belts.
- 4. Not possess, use or be under the influence of alcohol and/or illegal drugs while involved in any American Cancer Society activity.
- 5. Not allow any youth to leave the premises of the event unless authorized by the youth's parent/guardian or by the person in charge of the event.
- 6. Avoid use of profanity, exhibit good sportsmanship, serve as a positive role model, and demonstrate reasonable conflict resolution skills.
- 8. Abide by all applicable laws and rules, policies, and guidelines.
- 9. Follow the directions of event staff and leadership.
- 10. Participate in activities to the best of their abilities.
- 12. Appreciate the valuable role that youth play in the American Cancer Society.

I have read this Code of Conduct, I understand its contents, and I agree to its terms. I also understand that if I do not follow the above guidelines, my participation in this event will be terminated.
