Charter Bus Policies

Refunds will only be given if the bus's minimum passenger requirement has been exceeded. Refunds will be returned within 14 days from the date of the trip.

If the travel company's deadline to sign-up has passed.

NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN.

If the charter Bus or Venue changes the program, the paid participant has a right to cancel and receive a full refund. Signing up for trips costing \$100 or greater can be paid by placing a 25% deposit, the balance due by trip's sign-up deadline. All overnight trip prices are based on double occupancy. Payment must be made in full by deadline. All charter bus trips depart from the Forest Township Area Senior Center. Please arrive 15 minutes prior to departure time. All Medical /Transportation forms must be filled out and current prior to the trip. On all casino trips, carry 2 pieces of ID in case you win a jackpot.

Transportation

We have our own bus available to bring you to and from the center. Call a day ahead to ensure a ride, subject to availability. Cost is \$2.00. This bus is **not** handicap accessible. If you need an accessible vehicle, a ride can be arranged through MTA "Your Ride".

Transportation Policy for Center Bus

The following seat reservation policy has been implemented due to the number of cancellations and no shows on outings. A reservation fee is due at the time you sign-up for an outing. This fee can vary depending on the trip and is **nonrefundable** (unless seat is filled after minimum seat reservation has been met). The minimum of 5 seat reservations required for a trip to go. This fee applies to all trip currently listed.

Recipe of the Month

No-Bake Chocolate Peanut Butter Coconut Bites

Ingredients

1 cup peanut butter

1/2 cup honey

1/2 cup unrefined coconut oil

(unrefined is important here for the coconut flavor)

2 cups rolled oats (not instant oats)

1 cup coconut

1/2 cup chopped pecans

1 1/4 cups dark or semi-sweet chocolate chips

1 tsp vanilla extract

Optional: toasted coconut for topping

Melt the peanut butter, honey and coconut oil in a medium size saucepan over medium-low heat. Stir frequently as the mixture melts. When it has melted, remove from the heat and stir in the remaining ingredients. Stir until the chocolate has melted and the ingredients are well combined. Pour into an 8x8 pan (9x13 is fine as well). Refrigerate until the chocolate hardens, at least 3-4 hours. Slice into 1 - 2 inch square pieces. Store in refrigerator.


