New Commandment Ministry

God is calling the men of Christ Church to reach out and care for the widowed, single parents and others with long term needs in our church family and community. We plan to train and deploy teams of men that will commit to permanently adopt care receivers that need support.

Teams will be comprised of four men and each man is asked to donate three hours of time one Saturday morning each month. On a typical service day, all the teams meet at the church for one hour of prayer and bible study. Then they break up into their teams and go and work in the home of their care receiver. The men do basic chores and support around the house. At the end of their time, the men gather around their care receiver and pray with them.



Each month, the team returns to the same care receiver, so their relationship with them extends over months and possibly years. The men are also asked to pray for the street they are working on and they may make their services available to other people in the neighborhood .

If you are interested in learning more about serving in this ministry, we will periodically have **Orientation and Registration Sessions** at Christ Church. To serve in this ministry you **MUST** attend an orientation and have a background check. Please check with Tim Steinbeck for upcoming session dates.
