Rimrock Shootout Tournament 2014 Rules/Regulations

Schedule of Play: Opening games will start at 8 am on Saturday and Sunday.

Game Rules: MHSA rules will be followed in all games with the following additions:

- 1. Games will consist of 2 twenty minute halves with a running clock except for timeouts and the last two minutes of the 2nd half.
 - a. In case of over time ~ 1st OT will be 2 minutes, 2nd OT will be first point wins.
- 2. Each team is allowed 3 time outs per game and one time out per overtime, no carry over.
- 3. Free Throws: Will be shot only on shooting fouls except for the last 2 minutes of the **second** half, in which shooting fouls will be two shots, unless basket is counted, and all other fouls will be one and one.
- 4. Three point shots are allowed.
- 5. Defense: 5th grade level: NO full court press. 6th 8th grade level: Full court press is allowed, but NOT after team has gained a 10 point lead. We encourage all teams to play man to man defense.
- 6. Players must play in there own grade classification. Exception: Player may play in an older division, but for only ONE team.
- 7. Once the tournament has started, pickup players will not be allowed, except for emergencies with gym supervisor's approval.
- 8. Shoes cannot be worn into the facility and then used for the game. Shoes must be non-marking.
- 9. Two coaches per team will be allowed on the bench.
- 10. Only teams playing in the current game will be allowed on the court during time outs and half time.

Officiating: Whenever possible, games will be officiated by MOA officials.

Game location: All games will be played at Billings West High School.

Roster: Players can only play for one team. Addition/Deletions must be completed by the first game.

Uniforms: Teams must have numbered/matching colored uniforms. It is recommended that teams show up with 2 sets of tops.

Lineups: Team coaches will put lineup in the official book 10 minutes prior to the scheduled game.

Game Ball: Game balls will be provided, all games will use an official high school girls' basketball.

Warm-up Balls: Each team must supply their own warm-up balls.

Conduct: A team may be suspended from further play for unsportsmanlike behavior by its players, coaches, managers, or fans.
