Primary Swimming PP to Year 7

Children in Pre Primary to Year 7 commence their swimming lessons on Monday 2 December. There are ten lessons, one each morning at the Cannington Leisureplex Pool beside Coker Park.

The children will walk to and from the lessons.

They will need to have returned to the school their swimming enrolment/permission forms by Friday 29 November.

Each day children will need:-

- Thongs or footwear to walk to and from the pool
- Bathers and a towel
- Top to wear over their bathers – school top would be okay
- Hat
- Water bottle

The children change into these clothes before they leave. If they are in the first group they may come to school in their bathers.

Group 1: Rooms 4.1, 6.1, 6.3 and 9.1

Get ready from 8:40 – Leave at 8:50 – Lesson at 9:10 recess on return.

Group 2: Rooms 5.2, 6.2, 6.5 and 9.2

Get ready from 9:25 – Leave at 9:35 – Lesson at 9:55 recess on return.

Group 3: Rooms 4.2, 6.4 and 5.1

Recess at 10:00

Get ready from 10:15 – Leave at 10:25 – Lesson at 10:45.

After their lesson they walk back to school and change back into their school uniforms.

All of the lessons are finished by lunch time.

End of Semester Reports

How will I know that my student is doing OK?

The end of semester student reports will be mailed during the holidays. On the front of the report there is an explanation of the report. It is important that parents read this information because the grading system being used A,B,C,D,E relates to student achievement for each Learning Area and is not aligned with the common understanding of grading A,B,C,D,E. Teachers will be in contact with parents if a student's grades are below the expected level for their year.

- A - Excellent: The student demonstrates excellent achievement of what is expected for this year level.
- B - High: The student demonstrates high achievement of what is expected for this year level.
- C - Satisfactory: The student demonstrates satisfactory achievement of what is expected for this year level.
- D - Limited: The student demonstrates limited achievement of what is expected for this year level.
- E - Very Low: The student demonstrates very low achievement of what is expected for this year level.

Extra Information Available on Reports (Years 1 to 10)

Parents can request a *School Position Report* for Semester 2, 2013. This additional printout provides written information that clearly shows your child's achievement in the subjects studied compared to that of other children in the child's peer group at the College. The information shows you the number of students in each of the achievement levels A to E. *These reports are not available for Kindergarten and Pre Primary.* If you would like this additional report for Semester 2, 2013 please sign and return the slip below. Slips must be returned to the College office **no later than Friday 6 December 2013.**
