A Sailor's Valentine Class Tuesdays, October 13, 20 & 27, 5:30–8:30pm



Antique valentines were made of seashells, usually with a romantic message or a nautical design and brought home as gifts at the end of a long whaling voyage. They were thought to be made by the sailors while at sea but were made in Barbados and purchased when ships stopped at this port of call.

Trisha Brown has been studying this art for some time and will teach this beginner class at the WAG building. You will make a family heirloom to be treasured.

The valentine has a shell motif and a 1 1/2" ivory scrimshaw center. A handcrafted octagonal 10" cherry shadow box with glass will complete the valentine. Shell flower techniques and traditional paper dividers will be taught.
