APPLICATION FOR RESEARCH INTERNSHIP

SIPA Research Internships provide a valuable opportunity for students to work on public affairs and policy-related research topics with a full-time SIPA or other Columbia University faculty member in the interest of preparing for doctoral studies or a research-intensive career. A research internship fulfills the MIA/MPA internship requirement, and it can be taken for credits (see below). Interested students are responsible for identifying a full-time faculty member who is willing to supervise the research internship and to provide a brief report to the Office of Academic Affairs once internship has been successfully completed.

Interested students should submit the following form, including the signature of the interested faculty supervisor, to the Senior Assistant Dean of Academic Affairs, Rose Diaz, along with a brief summary of the proposed research and professional objectives. This summary is part of the application. If the application is approved by the Senior Assistant Dean for Academic Affairs, the student next presents it for review by Associate Dean of Students Caroline Kay. Upon completion of the internship, the faculty supervisor must send a brief email to Dean Diaz, indicating that the internship has been successfully completed and that the student has demonstrated an appropriate level of research skills.

Step 2: Obtain signature of Dean Rose Diaz (Academic Affairs, OAA, IAB 1403, rd2614@columbia.edu), must have research summary available
