

**AUTHORIZATION FOR MINOR CHILD VISITATION**

I understand that minor child(ren) may only visit an incarcerated offender in the presence of the child's parent or legal guardian, or in the company of an immediate family member (who is at least 18 years old) of the child with the parent's/legal guardian's express written permission. I understand that "immediate family member" is defined by the Department of Corrections as grandparents; parents, to include step-parents and adoptive parents; sibling, to include brother, step or half-brother, sister, step or half-sister; aunt, and uncle.
