Hounslow Music Service – Individual Lessons at Saturday Music School

General

Individual lessons are available for any pupil on a Saturday morning at the Saturday Music School. Tuition is funded by the Department of Education and parental contributions.

How to arrange lessons for your child

Complete the attached application form and send this to the music office with your payment. We will do our best to provide lessons as soon as possible after receiving your application. We will contact you by email/telephone to arrange when these will start. If demand is too great for a teacher to accept all pupils to start at any time, then pupils will be accepted on a first come first served basis, following receipt of the application form at the Hounslow Music Office.

Lessons

The music service offers 30 lessons per academic year and lessons last for 30 minutes. There are usually 10 lessons in each term, and there is a published timetable of session dates available through the Music Office.

Instruments

Your child will need an instrument for their lessons. The Music Service is often able to hire instruments to pupils, depending upon availability, and we are also able to offer an Assisted Instrument Purchase Scheme whereby pupils receiving tuition through the service may be able to purchase new instruments at 0% VAT. Please note that the Assisted Instrument Purchase Scheme is only available in LA maintained schools. We are unable to hire drums or pianos.

Terms and Conditions

Fees

Fees are payable three times a year, at the beginning of each term. Lessons are terminated if invoices are not paid within the stated period.

Assisted Tuition Scheme (ATS)

The Music Service has agreed the level of assistance awarded to families in receipt of certain benefits (see attached schedule of fees). Assisted places are reviewed annually. Parents should notify this office immediately if their entitlement to benefit changes. Assistance for other reasons can be considered individually on receipt of written applications.

Assistance is available for one instrument only per child

Credits and refunds

We offer 30 lessons across the school year. Credits and refunds are normally considered at the end of the school year when it is clear how many lessons have been offered. If, for example, a teacher has been ill for three weeks during the Autumn Term and it has been impossible to arrange cover, there may be the opportunity to make up the missed lessons during the remainder of the year and invoices will be sent as normal. If, at the end of the year (July) it is clear that one or more of the three lessons has not been made up then please do contact the Hounslow Music Office by email or in writing.

If a pupil suffers a long term illness (ie four or more consecutive lessons missed) please advise the Music Office. Either a credit (for a continuing pupil) or a refund will be available. If a child opts to engage in another activity or is absent when there is a scheduled instrumental/vocal lesson, then this counts as a 'lesson offered' and no refund is available.

Withdrawals from courses of lessons

Written notice to withdraw from lessons without penalty must be received at the Hounslow Music Office by the following dates:

- 1st November (for withdrawal at the end of the Autumn Term)
- 20th February (for withdrawal at the end of the Spring Term)
- 11th June (for withdrawal at the end of the Summer Term)

<u>Verbal notification by pupils is not accepted</u>. If notification is received after these dates then half of the termly fee for the following term will be due in lieu of notice. Full fees are payable once lessons have commenced in any one term.

Temporary withdrawal from lessons

Lessons are offered during examination periods and pupils are expected to attend even if they are on study leave. Most pupils find that having something creative to complement their studies, in addition to revision, is not only possible but also beneficial. Continuing lessons cannot be guaranteed if pupils are withdrawn from the Instrumental/Vocal Tuition Scheme for a temporary period. However, parents may wish to pay for the lessons during the examination period in order to keep tuition open for the following year.

Reports

Instrumental/vocal teachers provide a comprehensive annual report in June.

Terms and Conditions

Parents and pupils are subject to all the terms and conditions set out in this document. Hounslow Music Service reserves the right to vary these terms and conditions when necessary.

Standard Fee £125 per term

Please note that assistance is available on one instrument only and so £125 will apply to lessons on a 2nd Instrument for all pupils on the Special Award

Sibling Discount – Special Award Scheme pupils only

50% reduction on Saturday Special Award scheme for siblings.

We are unable to give assistance for Contributions Based Income Support, Job Seekers Allowance and Employment Support Allowance.

Paired lessons are available under the Saturday Instrumental lessons scheme in certain circumstances.

Fees are subject to an increase annually in April

Financial assistance with fees is only available for one instrument (lessons and hire charges) per child. If an additional instrument is taken up, then full fees will be due on those extra lessons and hire.

Additional Time on either Special Award/Instrumental Lessons

It is possible, depending on teacher availability, to purchase a longer lesson on your main instrument. The additional fee will be as follows:

45 minute instrumental lesson – Special Award	£295 per term
