FYI ATTENDANCE POLICY

Dear Parent,

We thought it might be helpful to clarify the Lakeview attendance policy, as required by the district.

Please note, it includes both absences **and** tardies.

The Provo District attendance policy includes the following:

- 5 days of unexcused absences allowed each year.
- 3 tardies equal one unexcused absence.

• Parents who call in before 9AM and excuse the child get an excused absence.

- 5 excused absences are allowed per quarter.
- At 5 unexcused absences the district notifies the school of an attendance concern.
