

The Department of Public Works invites students to participate in a calendar design contest promoting the theme of **Eco Friendly Andover**. There is no fee to enter and the only requirement is that entrants be of school age between kindergarten and twelfth grade and live in Andover or attend Andover Public Schools. Published calendars will be available for sale with proceeds to be used towards **Eco-Friendly** collaborative projects between the Department of Public Works and the Andover Public Schools District.

The published calendar will be comprised of four (4) functions of Public Works. Each of these environmentally important functions will be featured for three months on the calendar during the year. Each poster submitted for a function must include one or more of the suggested topics listed under the designated function;

FUNCTIONS/TOPICS

Single stream recycling

- What can be and what cannot be recycled
- Items that can be reused instead of trashed
- How does Single Stream Recycling work?
- How does recycling save money?

Water Conservation

- How can water be conserved around the house (showers, sinks, etc.)
- Why it is important to conserve water?
- The importance of water in the community and in the world
- Lawn and garden care practices that can conserve water

Composting

- What can be composted
- The cycle of composting
- How compost can be used
- Who can compost?

Environmental Protection

- Activities that can protect the environment on a daily basis
- Household hazardous waste and the proper disposal of these items.
- Energy saving tips
- Stormwater pollution prevention

JUDGING

One winner will be chosen by grade level for each function as listed. Entries may be submitted individually or as a group (such as a classroom).

The grade level/age ranges shall be as follows:

- Kindergarten Elementary
- Middle School
- High School

Posters should be:

- Colorful
- Completely hand drawn, painted, etc.
- Computers should not be used to make these posters, but any other medium is accepted.
- 8½ by 11 sheet of paper and drawn in a landscape/horizontal orientation.

Artwork will be judged based on how clear the message is, the creativity and originality, the clarity of the picture/writing, and the brightness and color. Be sure to clarify which of the themes is being illustrated in your poster. All eligible Contest entries will be judged by a panel of judges as designated by the DPW. Winners will be notified on or about November 15, 2013.

Winning posters will be chosen to appear on the DPW's **Eco Friendly Andover 2014 Calendar**. In addition, the posters will be on display around the Town of Andover and on our Facebook page (www.facebook.com/AndoverDPW)! Winners and their families or classrooms (depending on how poster is submitted) will also receive a 35-gallon recycling toter from the Department of Public Works.
