Novi High School is proud to bring back the 7th Annual Novi Winter Fire-up Competition. This is an innovative cheerleading competition that can fire up your team to begin their season. We have invited officials from the west side of the state to score the meet and provide individualized feedback. Each team will be provided time to meet with one of the officials, ask questions, and discuss their performance and results. Teams can compete with all three rounds or select just one or two. This is designed as a learning experience for teams so places and awards will not be handed out. We will still display all of the teams' scores and provide detailed results of all team scores. Please review the following and call if you have any questions.

Officials: Officials have been invited from the west side of the state.

Classifications: All Middle School, Freshman, JV, and Varsity teams are invited

Tournament Date: Saturday, December 5, 2015
School opens @ 7:30 AM – space will be provided in the atrium for food & drink consumption – THERE WILL BE NO FOOD OR DRINK IN THE GYMNASIUMS!

Entry Fee: \$75 per team for one round
\$130 per team for two rounds
\$160 per team for three rounds

Spectator Admission: Tickets are \$5.00 each for all persons aged K – 62. No passes accepted

Entry Forms: Entry forms / contract – due by November 24, 2015

Squad Size: Those team members in uniform and on the competing team roster will be admitted free of charge. Members of other teams from the same school who are not competing will be charged the spectator admission fee of \$5.00.

Warm-Up: We will have three mats set up in the field house for warm-up. A warm-up schedule will be provided when you arrive.

Supervision: Coaches should supervise their student-athletes at all times.
Student-athletes should remain in the field house, performance gym or atrium and should not wander the building.

Spectator Video: There are no provisions for videotaping the competition. Parents wishing to video may do so as long as they do not interrupt the opportunity for other spectators to watch the competition. No power will be provided.

Athletic Trainer: An athletic trainer will be present to evaluate and treat injuries. Routine wrapping and taping will be done as long as the schools bring supplies as no supplies will be provided for this purpose.
