- I will not use tobacco products, drugs or alcohol. I will not bring a weapon on to site. The exception is a personal bow for scheduled archery practice, and the bow is immediately turned in during check in.
- I will respect the environment, camp equipment, the camp, the property as well as campers' & staff members' personal belongings.
- I have read the Internet Safety Pledge and agree to follow it if I choose to interact with the camp online community. A copy of the pledge is included on the second page.

I have read & understand the rules. I agree to follow them and will also help enforce them. If I am with someone who is breaking one of the above rules, I understand that I also could be subject to disciplinary action.

A violation of the above will be dealt with according to the severity and may include but not be limited to:

- Losing of the privilege of participating in future Trefoil Academy camps at the discretion of the Camp Director.

- I will follow all of the Girl Scout Terms and Conditions related to Digital Cookie, as well as all internet safety guidelines related to all other Girl Scout product sales.
- I will practice online etiquette (good manners) at all times when online by:
  - Not spamming others.
  - Not bullying or tolerating bullying (and will always tell a trusted adult if this is a problem).
  - Not using bad language.
