## Post Bingo Update

After much discussion the Post will join the Auxiliary in having progressive bingo. We will begin this on Wednesday, October 7.

It will cost 3 dollars per sheet of three squares. The first week we will draw 48 numbers for a black out game, if no one gets bingo by the 48th number the pot [\$300] increases at the next scheduled game night, where we will draw 49 bingo numbers. Every scheduled post bingo night we increase the numbers drawn and the money in the pot until someone wins.



That first night we continue past the 48 until someone wins, at which time that winner gets the consolation prize of \$100. It is important to note that the winner of the progressive bingo must present two [2] forms of government approved id. If they do not have this id we will hold their winnings until they can produce the needed id.

We hope that this change to progressive bingo will draw in more players and increase our profits so that we can use those profits to help those in need. With an increase in players the need for volunteers to help at bingo will increase, so please think of volunteering on bingo nights.


