MISSIONS AND PRAYER

West Africa

Ask that God would intervene and contain the spread of the Ebola virus in Liberia and other countries in West Africa. Pray for the Liberian Baptists who are responding to the crisis in the local communities where they serve. Ask that health-care workers be given immunity to this deadly disease, as they care for the sick and fight further infection.

Middle East

Please pray for the Christians in Iraq. Ask that the Holy Spirit empower them to remain steadfast in their witness to Christ despite persecution. Pray for their safety and an end to the violence against minority groups in Iraq. Ask that Christians be given the strength to bless those who persecute them and the ability to forgive their persecutors.

Colombia

The wife of a pastor who serves in one of Colombia's "red zones" was shot to death recently by FARC guerillas. Pastor James and his family were the only Christians in their village, and his wife very active sharing Christ with everyone she met. Please pray for Pastor James and his four daughters who mourn the unexpected loss of their greatly missed wife and mother. May the Lord provide safety and shelter for this family as they mourn, shielding each one of them from further attack. In addition, remember in prayer the other brave men and women who are ministering in dangerous areas of Colombia, that God would grant them wisdom and endurance as they serve Him at great personal risk.

Nigeria

Attacks against churches result in more casualties. At least four Christians and a soldier were killed in the city of Kano, Kano State, on July 27th after a bomb was thrown over a church's fence as believers were leaving their Sunday worship service. Many other Christians were hospitalized with injuries. Please pray that the Lord will not only protect them from further attack but also greatly strengthen their faith and encourage their hearts. May they look to Jesus for the grace to forgive their persecutors and earnestly love and pray for all who oppose them.

International

Monday was International Day in Support of Victims of Torture. Please remember all the people who are detained for their beliefs and are tortured for standing up to illegitimate power structures. Ask that those who face persecution and torture would sense Jesus' presence and that His followers will be given the grace to remain faithful to Him. Ask that the Holy Spirit restrain those who resort to torture and they would turn from their wicked ways.

Africa

Pray for Randy and Elizabeth Legassie serving as CBM Field Staff in Kenya. The Legassies will be leaving Kenya in mid August after completing their current assignment. Ask for a smooth transition and the Lord's leading and provision as they discern what is next. Pray also for peace as they move into the next phase of their lives and ask the Lord to send people who will be able to fill in the gaps left by their departure.

Iraq

Please continue to pray for the numerous displaced members of our persecuted family in Iraq, especially those who were recently forced to flee from the city of Mosul under threat of death.

Canada

Please pray for the church in Quebec. Ask that God by His Spirit would make people come alive in and to Christ. Pray for those who are spreading the gospel and planting new churches in this province. Pray that they would be strengthened and that they would be sensitive to the Holy Spirit as they speak and minister to people. Ask that God would provide for them and supply all the resources needed. Pray that he would send believers willing to disciple new believers.
