Missions and Prayer

Global

We pray for strength and courage for our global church partners serving in places of great conflict and upheaval. May their hope and love reach into the fear and despair around them. We remember especially our partner, the Baptist Community of Central Africa (CBCA) in DR Congo as they help churches and villages affected by recent massacres. CBM has responded with emergency relief.

Lebanon

Life in Lebanon is becoming more difficult by the day, with four million Lebanese and the Syrian refugee population at two million inside the country. The stresses on the economy and on already-suffering infrastructure are debilitating. In the middle of this confusion, opportunities to serve and to proclaim the Gospel are emerging daily, as the Church is discovering its role as an agent of peace and reconciliation. Please pray for the Lebanese church, as they are being transformed into vibrant and bold witnesses of the Gospel, in

word and deed. Also pray for displaced communities that are being transformed as they experience first-hand, many for the first time, the love of God through His people.

Beirut, Lebanon

Elie serves as President of the **Arab Baptist Theological Seminary** (ABTS) in Beirut, Lebanon. ABTS equips leaders for the Church in the entire Arabic-speaking world. Mireille serves with Heart for Lebanon, a Christian NGO that provides humanitarian aid and relief to marginalized people groups, including the ever increasing number of refugees who continue to enter Lebanon. Mireille works primarily among female refugees, caring for them physically, emotionally, educationally, and spiritually. Please pray for their roles in their respective work, that God may grant them with wisdom and guidance, as well as for their safety. Pray also for the students and refugees they work with every day, that they may learn and know the love of Christ in all circumstances.

CBM – (Canadian Baptist Ministries)

Please continue to pray for our co-workers in the field. One of the most powerful ways you can help people with disabilities through CBM is by praying for our co-workers. These CBM staff work in the world's poorest countries, far away from family and friends, sometimes in communities hostile to the Christian faith.
