Accepted students who cancel participation on or before January 20, 2012, will not receive the registration fee of \$300 refunded, but are not required to pay the balance of the program fee or tuition. Students who cancel participation after the January 20, 2012 deadline are required to pay the full program fee balance and tuition, if applicable. If you apply for financial aid but do not receive the aid by the deadline, Hofstra will accept a letter from your school stating that you will receive financial aid for the program.
