- 2. One Page Essay (12 pt. font, double spaced) written by you describing how/this scholarship would benefit you and what your long-term goals and education plans are.
- 3. An Official High School Transcript.
  - Scholarship amount will be \$1,500.
  - Scholarship will be payable \$750.00 per semester.
  - Funds will be paid directly to institution.
  - Funds may be used for room, board, books or tuition.
  - The scholarship is not renewable.
  - Student must be attending a state accredited institution (college, university or technical school.)
  - Student must maintain a minimum of a 2.0 grade average (4.0 scale) at a college, university or technical school
