Thank you for your interest in the Tulsa State Fair Junior Livestock Show Scholarship Program. It is not necessary to have made the Junior Livestock Auction to be eligible for a scholarship.

- **Extra Curricular Activities associated with your high school or community**
- **Economic Need**
- **Short Essay describing your educational plans and long term goals**

**An Important Note Regarding Financial Need:**

Financial need is defined as an inability to pay for a substantial portion of college tuition because of basic financial challenges. It is not determined by lack of parental willingness to pay nor is it influenced by parental financial obligations in the face of a generous level of income. However, each application will be individually reviewed and extraordinary family circumstances will be considered.

We thank you for participating in the Tulsa State Fair over the years and hope that we have the opportunity to help further your education as a reward for the hard work and lessons learned from exhibiting an animal at the Fair.

The following items must be attached to this application to be considered a complete and valid application:

1. Two letters of reference – One letter from your school (teacher, advisor, principal) and one letter from someone in your community other than the school.
2. One Page Essay (12 pt. font, double spaced) written by you describing how/this scholarship would benefit you and what your long-term goals and education plans are.
3. An Official High School Transcript.
  - Scholarship amount will be \$1,500.
  - Scholarship will be payable \$750.00 per semester.
  - Funds will be paid directly to institution.
  - Funds may be used for room, board, books or tuition.
  - The scholarship is not renewable.
  - Student must be attending a state accredited institution (college, university or technical school.)
  - Student must maintain a minimum of a 2.0 grade average (4.0 scale) at a college, university or technical school
