Scrambled Place Value Mixed Review

Solve the equations below. Place value can be expressed in many different forms. At times numbers can be written in standard form, while other times you may see numbers in written form. A good mathematician should be able to translate the way you see numbers. Translate the following equations:

$$3 \text{ hundreds} + 2 \text{ ones} = \underline{\quad}$$
