On Saturday, August 27th, the board and staff of Love INC met at Calvin Church for a Strategic Planning Retreat to discuss how we can transform Love INC from a "good" organization to a "great" one. The retreat was facilitated by Karen Woods, who discussed the importance of planning. You may have heard the saying, "If you fail to plan, plan to fail".

The group discussed our Vision, Mission and Core Values and felt they are great and represent not only who we are but who and what we want to be. We looked at our past trends and at graphs showing unmet needs in Muskegon as reported by CALL 2-1-1. We discussed our Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats. These were captured by Karen and will be discussed at a future meeting of the Planning Committee. Their goal will be to prioritize, develop objectives and action plans and get input from other stakeholders including church leaders, volunteers and donors.

We continually strive to grow and serve people better and meeting like this on a Saturday morning shows the commitment that we as staff and board have to make this happen. God expects us to model excellence and when acts of service are rendered in that manner, excellence has a way of showing through; it has nothing to do with "self", but everything to do with "whatever you do, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ". In some cases, this means discerning the difference between enabling and empowering. Excellence has nothing to do with how big or even how many, but how well.
