A Volunteer's Testimony By Cheryl Pollice

"Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you a drink? When did we see you as a stranger and welcome you, or naked and give you clothes? Then the king will reply to them, When you have done it for one of the least of these, you have done it for me.' Matt 25:37-40.

God is always so faithful - in the good and bad times. Over and over He has provided for me and my family, meeting needs not often shared with anyone else. His answers show His true power and awesomeness! This deeply implanted in me a desire and understanding of the importance to be His tool to help others. There are many volunteer opportunities – how would I pick the right one?

In our weekly church newsletter, there was an ad for Intake Volunteers at Love INC of Muskegon. I thought and prayed about it. I shared the idea with my husband, who thought it would be a good fit. Following God's direction, I contacted Love INC about the position. I wanted to be there, and it shows in my commitment. More important than having skills and ability is having the **DESIRE** to serve and help others. God supplies everything else.

When a Neighbor in Need calls or comes into the office, they provide information about their situation, need and finances. I ask additional questions to clarify if needed. After assessing their information, I am better prepared to know how I can help, whether it is referring them to a pantry or a class Love INC offers, or by providing additional services for someone who has lost everything in a fire or has other extenuating circumstances.

The tightening economy has brought many first time Neighbors to Love INC. Some are embarrassed to ask for help. I offer reassurance that they do not need to feel embarrassed; we all need help sometimes. In some situations, I gently tell them that I understand because I have been there. Then, I reiterate Love INC's commitment to provide assistance whenever possible.

Some requests are beyond the scope of what Love INC can do. In those situations, we may refer to another resource, suggest eliminating unnecessary expenses and/or suggest pantry visits to free up cash. Everything in me wants to help in desperate situations but sometimes the best help I can give is the hope we have in Christ by praying with and for them.

I have been a volunteer since early 2011, and it is a privilege to be part of this ministry team; team members who are now friends. It is humbling to be used as God's tool to help others, and perhaps lighten their load by giving them encouragement. I have learned so much, and have more to learn.

I prayed about this decision, God answered, and I am helping to make a difference for our Neighbors in Need in Muskegon County.

Clearinghouse News by the Numbers January—March 2012

- 412 families received food impacting 1335 individuals
- 371 families utilized our personal care pantries impacting 871 individuals
- 212 individuals received clothing
- 53 families received household items
- 82 infants slept in safe cribs, received layettes, pampers and formula or received other services for infants
- 87 families & individuals participated in our New Directions budget series
- 109 families & individuals completed our Positive Parenting series
- 17,045 is the number of hours our volunteers have given.

Love INC partners with area churches to provide 21 food pantries, 3 personal care pantries, a household goods pantry, Muskegon Res cue Mission clothing partnership, a crib ministry, a baby pantry, a layette ministry, a twin bed ministry and Life Skills classes.

On May 1st we celebrated with our volunteers at their annual recognition banquet. This year it was held at Forest Park Covenant Church. We had over 140 volunteers attend and everyone seemed to enjoy themselves. I just want to take a minute to thank the volunteer banquet sponsors who made that night possible.
