<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❑ Backpack ❑ Complete class "A" uniform (wear) ❑ Hiking boots/water resistant shoes ❑ Socks - at least 1 pair class "A" if wearing shorts + 1 extra pair. ❑ Troop sweatshirt ❑ (1) extra pair of pants ❑ (1) warm hat ❑ (1) pair underwear/t-shirts ❑ (1) pair long johns ❑ (1) class "B" t-shirt ❑ Jacket or coat ❑ (2) pair of gloves ❑ Rain gear ❑ Flashlight with extra batteries ❑ Toiletry kit - toothpaste and brush, soap, small towel, deodorant, comb ❑ Water bottle or canteen ❑ Sleeping bag rated for at least 30°F (pack in a waterproof bag/trash bag) ❑ Drinking cup ❑ Scout book (in zip-lock baggy) ❑ Trash bag for wet items/dirty clothes ❑ Totin' Chip & Fireman Chit ❑ Scout knife ❑ Wrist watch, notebook, pen/pencil 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❑ Folding camp chair ❑ Day pack ❑ Cards/board games ❑ Scout shorts (weather dependent) ❑ Boots (weather dependent) <p style="text-align: center;"><u>DO NOT BRING:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Food, snacks, fruit, pop, etc. • Fireworks/firearms/axes/hatchets • Non-folding knives • Cell phones (Scouts) • Any electronics • TV's, computers, etc. • Personal tents without express permission <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Notes:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pack all items which can get wet into waterproof bags, ziplock/tied garbage bags, etc. • All medicines sent with Scouts must be in their original containers, with clear, written instructions. • An up-to-date part 'A' medical form must be on file with the Troop. Medical forms must be updated annually.
