There will be no fee charged for After School care prior to enrichment classes that start at 3:30pm, but if your child stays beyond the Enrichment class dismissal time, you will be charged at the regular After School rate. If your child is participating in a 4:30pm class, you will be responsible for the hour prior at the regular after school rate unless your child leaves and returns. Classes focus on swing path fundamentals with each stroke through fun and interactive methods of teaching. Players also get introduced to scoring in a fun, cooperative and competitive environment.

Players learn technical and tactical tennis skills, while continuously building athletic skills. Classes focus swing path fundamentals, classic grip and stroke development for the basic strokes learned in Little Aces and get to learn a new stroke - the serve. Players also learn how to keep score and rally in a fun, competitive environment.

#### **AFTER SCHOOL POLICIES**

Please read the following After School polices before signing your Enrichment registration form.

#### **Payment Policies**

In order to participate in the SSCA After School Program, you must be current with your payments. Accounts that fall behind by more than one month may result in your child's dismissal from After School.

#### **Monthly Invoices and Payments**

Monthly enrollment account invoices are due upon receipt and will be sent via email after the end of each month, since billing for monthly accounts is based on attendance. Your bill must be paid within two weeks after receiving the monthly invoice to avoid a late payment charge. Please pay promptly. Failure to pay on time will result in a \$25 late payment fee.

#### Upon registration the following payments are due:

- \* If you wish to receive the Annual payment discount of 20% your annual amount is due upon registration.
- \* If you wish to receive the Quarterly payment discount of 10% your first quarterly payment is due upon registration, (or on 9/15/15) and on the following three dates: 12/15/15, 03/15/16, 05/15/16.
- \* If you wish to pay on a monthly basis, your Deposit/ Prepayment of June fees (\$250 for single child/ \$300 for family) is due upon registration.

#### **Late Pickup Policy**

Children must be picked up by 6:00 PM. Please be on time! Parents will be billed \$20 per every quarter hour (15 minutes) after 6:00 pm. To avoid late fees, parents should make prior arrangements to have an authorized friend or backup person pick their child up if they know they might be late. Chronic or excessive late pick-up is inconsiderate to the After School Program staff and may result in your child's dismissal from the program.

#### **Sign-Out Policy**

The person authorized to pick up your child from After School must sign them out by printing their name, signing and writing the exact pickup time on the sign out sheet. This must be done in the presence of the teacher dismissing them. If you pick up your child after the above mentioned half hour dismissal times, you will be charged for the full half hour. If anyone other than the parent/ guardian is picking up they must be listed on the Authorized Persons for Pickup list, or you will need to send a note/email in writing notifying the school of who will be picking up that day. They will need to show photo ID upon request. If the person picking up the child neglects to sign him/her out, you will be charged until 6pm.

#### **Behavior Policies**

SSCA strives to create a warm, welcoming environment in which all students can thrive. We ask that all members of our school community take care of each other, the space, and themselves during After School. The SSCA After School Program staff is responsible for providing a positive experience for children and aligns itself with the teaching methods of Responsive Classroom®. We believe students can learn from their behavior and therefore, we want to emphasize logical consequences and making amends for the behavior. If a child's behavior adversely affects the experiences of other children, logical consequences will be implemented.

#### **Behavior Infraction**

- Behavior infractions are when a student's behavior is persistent and infringes on the teaching, learning or well being of the group.
- Possible consequences of a Behavior infraction:
  - Solve the problem that you created (i.e. "you break it, you fix it")
  - Write an apology letter
  - Loss of privileges
  - Separation from the group (i.e. a "time out" and/or joining a buddy classroom)
  - Inappropriate items may be confiscated
  - Meet with an administrator
  - SSCA will contact your family
  - Be suspended or dismissed completely from After School
- If there are more than three infractions (other than non-negotiables) the parent or guardian will be notified.

#### Non-Negotiables

Although Saint Saviour Catholic Academy faculty will do their best to make consequences logical, there are certain behaviors that are non-negotiable. These behaviors include, but are not limited to, physical violence or any action that puts the student or others at risk. These behaviors will result in immediate removal from the After School setting and parents may be notified to come pick up their children.

#### Personal Electronic Devices (PEDs) Policy

PEDs may include any portable Internet devices *except for cell phones*. PEDs include iPods, iPads, laptop computers, tablets, notebooks, netbooks, recording devices, etc. **The use of PEDs is permitted on school premises under limited conditions as authorized by the Principal and supervised by Classroom Teachers**. The sole purpose for using this technology is to enhance academic achievement while respecting the dignity and safety of all members of St. Saviour Catholic Academy.

#### **Cell Phones**

- In After School, students' cell phones must be kept turned off and in their backpacks or lockers during the school day. If not, they will be collected each day by the After School teacher, stored securely in the classroom and returned to students at dismissal.
- Please do not contact your child by cell phone during After School hours. In an
  emergency, or in the case that you need to notify them of when they will be picked up,
  messages should be left with the school's office.

#### Policy Regarding Adults in the School Building

All adults on the Saint Saviour Catholic Academy campus need to be VIRTUS trained in order to be with children in the building without another teacher present. As a reminder, our bathrooms are for children only. If an adult needs to use the bathroom or accompany their child to the bathroom, they may use the bathroom in the front office.
