THE “FOOLISHNESS” OF THE CROSS 1 Corinthians 1: 17-29

The cross is a central part of Christian teaching and theology. It is obvious that the message of the cross was also a key component in Paul’s preaching and teaching. There are many subjects he could have addressed as an itinerant evangelist writing and constantly traveling to new cities abroad. But Paul made it clear to the Corinthian believers that “*we preach Christ crucified*” (1:23).

Paul had a long list of issues to address with the Corinthian church, but not surprisingly, he barely pens his greetings to them, and then begins a lengthy discussion about the crucifixion of Christ. He approaches this key subject from three distinct perspectives . . .

I. The world’s point of view: Foolishness!
