## INFORMATION AND PROCEDURES: <u>Read and initial</u> each item below to show that you understand and agree to with the terms of the permit:

1. Parking of a recreational vehicle with an Annual Temporary Parking Permit shall be allowed for a maximum of three (3) consecutive days, up to twelve (12) days total per calendar month.

- 2. A two-year Temporary Parking Permit shall be valid for two years and expires on December 31st of the year on the permit.
- 3. Permitted recreational vehicles must park at least 15-feet from corners and fire hydrants.
- 4. To the extent possible, the recreational vehicle must be parked adjacent to the address the permit was issued to.
- 5. It is unlawful for any person to occupy, use, or permit the occupation or use of any motor vehicle for the purposes of sleeping, lodging, residence, guest accommodations, or habitation. This section shall not prohibit such use in areas designated for such purposes.
- 6. Connection of any motor vehicle, motor home, travel trailer, or any other vehicle which is equipped for sleeping, or cooking, or both, to any public utility such as water, electricity, gas or sewer services is prohibited except as may be necessary for the maintenance and preparation of the vehicle for more than eight (8) hours in any seven consecutive days;
- 7. City parking regulations take precedence over "Annual Temporary Parking Permits." Therefore, a recreational vehicle/trailer may not be parked on a City street during the hours and on the days that parking is prohibited on that street for street sweeping, or during the hours that parking is otherwise restricted by ordinance or statute.
