BACKGROUND: Northland's *Revised* Policy 3340 (ASSESSMENT FOR COURSE PLACEMENT POLICY) states that satisfactory completion of program required developmental courses must be achieved with a “C” or better in order for students to meet graduation requirements. All A.A.S, A.S. and A.A. degrees require full completion of, or placement above all levels of developmental courses. **Individual programs, however, determine developmental course requirements for each of their certificates or diplomas.** The purpose of this document is to have programs identify the developmental course requirements for certificates and diplomas.

DIRECTIONS: To complete this document, please find the rows that identify any certificate or diploma programs for which you are responsible, and place an X in the column for the highest required developmental courses for those certificates or diplomas. **Be certain to identify required courses for both the ENGL (Reading and Writing) sequence and MATH sequence.** Be certain to save this file to your desktop/computer, save changes you make, and then attach that file to an email and return to Brian.Huschle@northlandcollege.edu.

GUIDELINES: The members of the Developmental Education Committee have agreed to make themselves available to program faculty to guide course/level selection. Since the Reading/Writing courses are new, we are also offering the recommendation that programs check the reading level of required textbooks for the program. This can be done by typing in a text sample (a couple of paragraphs) into the following text analyzer: BlueCentauri (Click Link in Box Below). This analyzer identifies a "Grade Level" for the sample text entered. You can then use this to assist in identifying which developmental ENGL course (ENGL 0075, ENGL0085, or ENGL0095) your students need to help assure success in your program courses. For program areas with AAS or AS degrees that serve as a continuation of the diploma or certificate, it is further recommended that you consider the reading and math levels required for successful completion of those degrees in determining the level required for the certificate or diploma.
